<i>Dracaena draco</i>	Canary Island Dragon Tree	Tree	15-25' H x 15-25' W	Slow	Sun or shade	Infrequent		An attractive and interesting succulent tree.
<i>Echium simplex</i>	White Tower of Jewels	Shrub	4-8' H x 1-2' W	Fast	Full sun	Occasional		Flowers should be allowed to mature fully so that seed is produced to perpetuate the plant in the garden when it dies after its second or third year.
