

# MULTICULTURAL PERSPECTIVE TRAVEL PROGRAMS

Our Multicultural Perspective Travel programs are designed for those who'd like to experience all that the Mediterranean has to offer during their January and/or May Terms. Students will explore cultural differences and similarities throughout the cities and countries visited and can choose from the following options:



#### **PEOPLE'S OF SPAIN: CULTURAL DIVERSITY**

The course covers the history of the people that have settled the peninsula over the years, including linguistic and religious groups. The second part of the class will be dedicated to an indepth analysis of the latest wave of migrants including refugee populations as well as economic migrants from the Americas, Morocco and Asia. We will address resistance to diversity, conflict, racism, antisemitism, and the imposition of cultural and religious uniformity. Professors use Barcelona, Seville and Madrid as the classroom through field studies such as visits to historic sites, diverse neighborhoods, organizations that fight racism within Spain, NGOs helping immigrants, and more.






