- Australian Everlasting

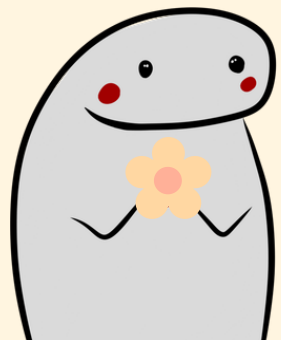
Seeds planted directly:

Fun Facts

- They belong to the Asteraceae family.
- The word *annuus* means annual.
- Sunflowers need well-draining soil & 6-8 hours of sunlight.
- The sunflower seeds can be eaten especially after being roasted.

- They can grow to be between 18-24 inches.
- They tend to be pink & white with yellow in the center.
- Rhodon means rose and anthos means flower.

- They belong to the Caryophyllaceae family.
- They can grow to be 18 inches.
- They grow in the colors pink, white, or a mix of them.
- These flowers are native to Europe and Northern Asia.

Calendula officinalis

- They belong to the Asteraceae family.
- Native to the Mediterranean.
- Common name is "pot marigold."
- Used in medicine as antibiotic and anti-inflammatory.

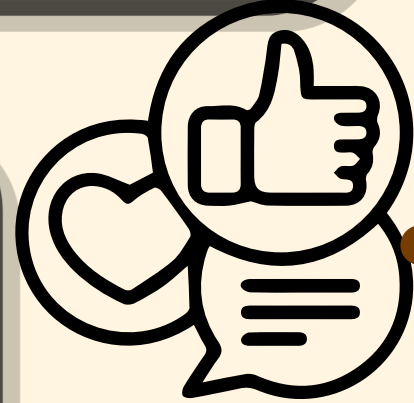

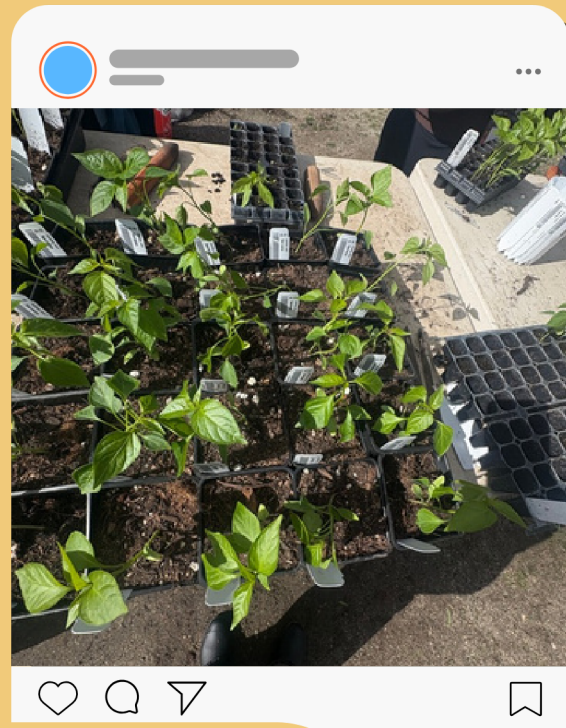
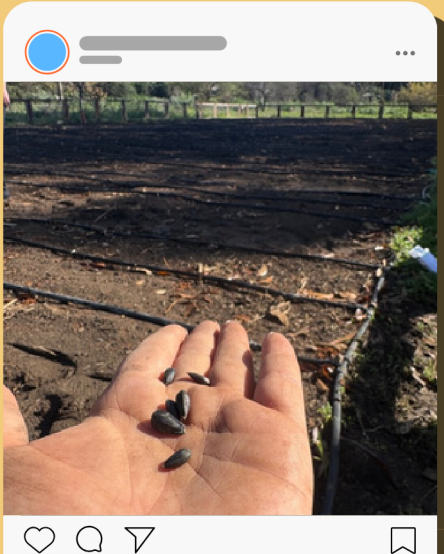
