# Event 3 - Initial Pitch

## Fruit and Orchard Team Event Proposal

### Event name Valencia Orange U-Pick

Tentative Date April 18 ,2026

Duration of Event 10 am - 1pm

Guest U-pick Duration:

- However long to fill 2 bags, limit to 10 people at a time depending on pruners
- If they take too long, we can help them pick to make it go faster
- We can also have pre-picked fruit to make it easier for them
- Encourage them to finish in a reasonable time so others can participate
- Limit to trees behind the Heritage House and around the outdoor classroom
- A Queue will probably be needed

Expected attendee's min 50 - max 200 (flower u-pick numbers)

- Sell Tickets at the kiosk on the day of or online if possible
- Member can be discounted or free, we can limit it to first come first serve

Ask for volunteers - other interns from other teams if possible

Goal and Objectives: To provide guests with fruit picking experience. Tie in history of Valencia orange

Have activities for the public to do, while they wait or after they are done participating

- Info Booth about oranges and the history of the orchards in the Arboretum
- Juice station to show the public what they can do with the oranges and who doesn't love juice
- Inform people about citrus greening with a booth and how to avoid it
- The climate team's citrus tour would be a great walk around activity while they wait, and they can learn more about the citrus trees
- We can have oranges slices as well

Target Audience: Families and past U-Pick Goers

Target Audience: Families and past U-Pick Goers

Supplies:

- 2 Bags per ticket the ones we use at kiosk
- Pruners
- Gloves
- Pole Pickers
- Spray and explain why you need to use it when changing trees
- Liability Waivers for each guest participating to sign

Admission:

- \$10 a person for non-members and you get 2 bags to fill
- Members could be free or discounted limited quantity
- Limit it to 150 or 200 tickets depending on how many oranges are available

Interns Roles during the event:

- Someone will run the main table and queue where people will check in
- Multiple interns will be monitoring and helping when people need help
- Tabling will be done by multiple interns with the informational posters and juice station
- Volunteers can help with both these tasks but probably the monitoring task
- We want to ensure people enjoy the picking process but don't take too long so people don't have to wait long

Summary: This would be the first fruit U-pick event at the CSUF Arboretum, and visitors would harvest oranges from selected trees. Guests will purchase tickets online, or at the kiosk, and be allowed to fill two bags of fruit, with a queue to manage crowds. Educational booths, juice demonstrations, and a citrus tour will be available while guests wait or after they finish picking. The event is expected to attract families and past U-Pick participants, with interns and volunteers helping run activities and supervise the orchard.
