

Referral Code FAQ for Bright Horizons

Q: What is a referral code?

A: A referral code is a special code provided to employees of partner organizations or attendees at certain workshops that offers a reduction/discount on the fees for eligible courses offered through CSUF Extension and International Programs.

Q: How do I get a referral code?

A: You would need to be an employee of one of our partner organizations (e.g. Bright Horizons) or have attended a workshop at which a referral code was provided.

Q: How long is the code good for?

A: There is no expiration date for the code. As long as you are an employee and the agreement between Bright Horizons and CSUF remains in effect, you may use it.

Q: Is there a limit to the number of times I can use the code?

A: No, there is no limit.

Q: Can I use the code on more than one course?

A: Yes.

Q: Can the code be used retroactively if I'm already enrolled in an EIP course?

A: No, but you may use it on the next course.

Q: Which certificate programs are eligible for the referral code?

A: Courses within the following certificate programs are eligible*:

- Crime and Intelligence Analysis
- Human Resources Management

Digital Marketing

- Lean Six Sigma Green Belt
- Geographic Information Systems (GIS)
- Professional Fiduciary Management for Trustees

*Eligible courses subject to change

Q: Does the referral code apply to the degree programs, SkillStorm, test prep or Ed2Go courses?

A: No, not at this time.

Q: Does using the referral code guarantee me enrollment in the courses of my choice?

A: No, the code does not guarantee enrollment. Enrollment is subject to seat availability and the meeting of prerequisites.
