The 51-unit program is cohort-based and takes three years to complete. There are 17 courses in the program and each class is 8 weeks in length (summer classes last 5 weeks). Once admitted, there are opportunities to accelerate your graduation.

## Eligibility

To be eligible for admission, you must have 60-69 transferrable semester units and have completed Introduction to Sociology or its equivalent. You must also be in good academic standing at the last college or university you attended, with a GPA of 2.5 or better. Conditional Admission is possible for applicants with fewer than 69 units.

You also must have completed a minimum of 30 semester units in CSU-approved General Education (GE) Coursework, with a grade of C or better. The GE coursework must include classes from the “Golden Four” requirements: Oral Communication, Written Communication, Critical Thinking and Mathematics/Quantitative Reasoning.
